

MINUTES OF BENTON COUNTY QUORUM COURT  
SPECIAL MEETING

**May 12, 2010**

A special meeting of the Benton County Quorum Court was held on Tuesday, May 11, 2010, upon recess of the regularly scheduled 6:00 p.m. Committee of Thirteen meeting at the Benton County Administration Building, 215 East Central Avenue, Bentonville, Arkansas, pursuant to proper call and notice.

The meeting was called to order by County Judge David Bisbee.

Deputy County Clerk Janet Reaves called roll as follows:

13 JPs Present: Wozniak, Wolf, Sandlin, Hubbard, Moore, Allen,  
Douglas, Blaty, Winscott, Harrison, Stephenson,  
Lewis

A legal quorum was present.

JP Wolf made motion to suspend the rules and read all resolutions and ordinances by title only, seconded by JP Douglas

Motion passed by unanimous voice vote.

County Judge David Bisbee stated the first item on the agenda is for the consideration of an emergency ordinance prohibiting the purchase, possession, and sale of "Spice" or "K-2".

" A Emergency Ordinance Prohibiting the Purchase,  
Possession, Sale, and Offering for Sale of the Synthetic  
Cannabinoid, Known as "Spice" or "K-2" and Declaring an  
Emergency"

Deputy Clerk Janet Reaves read the proposed emergency ordinance by title only.

JP Wolf stated that a presentation on "K-2" or "Spice" was made at the preceding Committee of Thirteen meeting, and that they understand that it is not only the "K-2" or "Spice" that needs to be prohibited, but also the

compound (JWH-018) additive. She noted that unlike marijuana, this compound cannot be detected through a urine test, and that makes it an even higher problem.

JP Wolf made motion to adopt this emergency ordinance with the special emergency clause, seconded by JP Winscott.

JP Lewis stated that she did not see the need for the emergency clause, because no one has died from an overdose of this compound.

There being no further discussion, a roll call vote was recorded as follows:

County Judge David Bisbee stated the proposed emergency ordinance has been adopted, and they now need a motion and vote on the emergency clause.

Deputy Clerk Janet Reaves read the proposed emergency clause in full. JP Wolf made motion that the proposed emergency ordinance with the emergency clause be adopted, seconded by JP Sandlin.

There being no further discussion, a roll call vote was recorded as follows:

Emergency Ordinance duly adopted and assigned **No. O-2010-20**

“An Appropriation Ordinance Amending Appropriation Ordinance No. O-2009-46 (2010 Benton County Budget) Appropriating Additional Monies and Authorizing Additional Expenditures in **Department 44, Capitol Projects, Fund 440**; and Amending *Schedule 1-Revenues by Fund* in the **2010** Benton County Budget.”

County Judge David Bisbee stated the proposed appropriation ordinance – Capitol Projects – Department 44, Fund 440 is to appropriate \$664,890 for Architect Fees and Bridge Construction on War Eagle Bridge.

Deputy Clerk Janet Reaves read the proposed appropriation ordinance. JP Moore made motion to adopt, seconded by JP Sandlin.

There being no further discussion, a roll call vote was recorded as follows:
