BE IT RESOLVED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF BENTON, STATE OF ARKANSAS, A RESOLUTION TO BE ENTITLED:

A RESOLUTION REFERRING AN ORDINANCE OF THE QUORUM COURT ESTABLISHING AN AMBULANCE SERVICE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT TO THE ELECTORS OF THE DISTRICT AT THE NOVEMBER 4, 2014 GENERAL ELECTION.

WHEREAS, the Quorum Court adopted Ordinance No. O-2014-___ creating an Ambulance Service Improvement District for Benton County and establishing a millage to fund the services to be provided by the District, and

WHEREAS, Arkansas law requires that said ordinance should be referred to the voters of the proposed District prior to its becoming effective, and

WHEREAS, § 14-14-905(f)(1)(a)(ii) of the Arkansas Code provides that the referral shall be in the form of a resolution and shall require a three-fifths affirmative vote of the whole number of justices constituting a quorum court;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF BENTON COUNTY, ARKANSAS THAT:

ARTICLE 1. Benton County Ordinance No. O-2014-___ creating an Ambulance Service Improvement District for Benton County and establishing a millage to fund the services to be provided is hereby referred to the electors of the proposed District at the November 4, 2014 General Election.

ARTICLE 2. Benton County Ordinance No. O-2014-___ shall become effective if approved by the voters upon certification thereof by the Benton County Election Commission.
